Care for Your Laptop Avoid Disciplinary Action! Remember:

DO NOT PUT THINGS BEHIND COMPUTER

Storing pens, papers, and other materials behind the screen or under the computer puts pressure on it and can lead to catastrophic damage.



WATCH FOR ITEMS AROUND SCREEN

Before closing your laptop, be sure there are not objects on or around the keyboard that can damage the screen. Your computer screen is fragile and must be treated with care.



DO NOT SIT ON OR ABUSE YOUR CASE

Classmate products are not load bearing. They should not be used as chairs, ottomans, step stools, or podiums. Nor should they be thrown, kicked, stepped on, used in hand-to-hand combat, written on, defaced, or otherwise mistreated.



DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS UNATTENDED

Your case contains a valuable piece of technology that thieves would like to take. Make sure you always keep your computer within eyesight, on campus or off. Do not leave in an unoccupied vehicle.



KEEP FOOD AND DRINKS AWAY

Classmate cases offer a large amount of protection to your computer, but they do not waterproof your device. Food and drink can still cause damage, so keep them away from the computer when it is in use.
