Introduction

Your TOUGHBOOK Rotating Hand Strap is uniquely designed to provide ease in transportation for your device.

Features



- 1) D-Rings
- 2) Nylon Webbing Straps
- 3) Webbing Glides



- 4) Adhesive Velcro
- 5) Hand Strap Base

Installation

Before installation, make sure the tablet portion of your device is separated from the keyboard and laid face down on a soft surface.





Remove the backing from the Adhesive Velcro (4) on the Hand Strap Base (5). Then, align the hand strap with the slots built into the device and firmly press down. Allow this Velcro to cure for 24 Hours before using the hand strap with the device to ensure a strong bond.

To install the straps, insert the tapered end of the Nylon Webbing Strap (2) into the slot that is built into the device. Push the strap through and when the end emerges from the other side of the slit pull the strap through and then thread it back through the Webbing Glide (3) as shown in the below image.



To finish installation loop the Nylon Webbing Strap (2) back through the bottom of the Webbing Glides (3). This ensures a tight connection to the device that will support use of the included Shoulder Strap.



The D-Rings(1) are designed to allow the attachment of the included Shoulder Strap to provide an enhanced user experience for the device.

Tips For Use

- The included Shoulder Strap can be attached to any of the 4 D-Rings to fit your specific need or use case.
- 2. By loosening the Nylon Webbing Straps you can easily access and remove the battery cover from your device or attach a gadget pack.
- 3. The Rotating Hand Strap can be loosened or tightened to better fit your hand via the Velcro on the inside of the hand cuff.
